A. Approve Resolution No. 0320-222 - Dr. Schmidt

Dr. Schmidt recommended adoption of Resolution #0320-222 to amend the previously adopted Resolution #0320-221 for allowance to compensate employees during the mandated closure of schools due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mrs. Harlow made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 0320-222 as recommended by Dr. Schmidt to amend Resolution #0320-221 which was previously adopted by the board on March 12, 2020; seconded by Mrs. Chavez. Motion carried 3-0.

B. Approve Resolution No. 0320-223 - Dr. Schmidt

Dr. Schmidt recommended adoption of Resolution #0320-223 which will empower the Superintendent to make decisions to keep schools running including approval of claims and payroll during the mandated school closure due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dr. Schmidt noted that school board meetings will also be limited to essential matters until schools are reopened. Mrs. Chavez made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 0320-223 to empower the Superintendent to make decisions to keep schools running during the COVID-19 pandemic as recommended by Dr. Schmidt and provided in the board packet; seconded by Mrs. Harlow. Motion carried 3-0.

4. SUPERINTENDENT REPORT - Dr. Schmidt

Dr. Schmidt reported that she has received a number of emails from certified and classified staff thanking the district for continuing their compensation during this unpredictable time.
