Seasons Basketball Code of Conduct - It is a privilege to be a part of Seasons Basketball.

- As a coach, assistant coach, or parent of Season Basketball I will not hold Porter Township School Corporation or Season Basketball responsible for any injury, loss, or theft during the season.
- Positive behavior is a key expectation for youths participating in Seasons Basketball. Positive behavior reflects trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship. Participants are expected to fully participate, follow all program rules, guidelines, bylaws, and to behave appropriately to ensure a high-quality learning experience and ensure the safety of all participants.
- Theft, vandalism, the use of illegal drugs and alcohol, and other such offenses are strictly prohibited. Anyone involved with these offenses will immediately be expelled from the club. Those engaged in illegal activities will be turned over to the proper authorities. Repair costs for damages incurred to property will be billed to those responsible.
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents are expected to maintain a higher level of sportsmanship, professionalism and integrity both off and on the court.
- Coaches & parents primary responsibility is for his/her player(s) to have fun, develop skills, and instill a passion for the game.
- Your performance as a coach or parent is not measured in wins and losses, but rather in what you teach your player(s) in terms of technique, sportsmanship, and fair play.
- Coaches & parents must maintain respect for the game, as well as the referees.
- Coaches & parents are charged with the responsibility of controlling their player(s) at all times during a match.
- Coaches & parents lead and teach by example; your player(s) will be a reflection of you!
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents are expected to have a basic knowledge of the game and rules.
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents should use positive reinforcement when dealing with player(s). Never use foul or abusive language and never abuse a player mentally, verbally, or physically.
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents are expected to have respect for the authority of the referee. They will not harass, abuse, or berate the referee during or after the match. They shall not enter the court without the referee's permission.
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship both on and off the court. They are to teach his/her players the rules of the game and proper play and behavior.
- Winning is a consideration, but not the only one, nor the most important one. Care more about the children than winning the game.
- Coaches, assistant coaches, and parents are to abide by and help enforce the most recent guidelines given by the league at all times to ensure the guidelines are in compliance with the state and local governing bodies. This includes all Covid-19 guidelines that can change from time to time.
