

2021-2022 PTSC PK-12 COVID Continue to Learn Plan: **Effective February 23, 2022**

School Status	In-person learning (unless staffing cannot be maintained or the health department advises closure)
Health Screening	All staff/students screen prior to coming to school. If your child is sick for any reason, keep them home from school
Mask Status	Masks are optional in all PTSC buildings
Social Distancing	3 feet of social distance encouraged
Hand Washing	Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette is taught and encouraged
Cleaning	Increased cleaning/focus on high-touch surfaces during the day, mist wand in the evening
Contact Tracing	We will follow all Indiana Department of Health Guidelines. We will provide notifications if we are aware of staff or student exposure to a COVID-positive individual. The individual should then monitor for symptoms.
Bus	Masks required by Federal law (we will make changes when the federal mandate changes)
Visitors	Masks optional
Virtual	<p>We believe in-person learning is the BEST OPTION for MOST students. Virtual will be offered this year with the following stipulations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● K-8: Only offered if as an accommodation for a medically documented need (contact your building principal) ● Semester commitment (administration may place on virtual for a limited basis, but students/parents may not “select” virtual for the day) ● Parent commitment to support your child in the virtual program by monitoring his/her progress ● Parent commitment to bring your child to school for any required in-person testing ● Parent commitment to provide access to reliable wi-fi during the school day ● Parent commitment to provide a home environment conducive to learning for your child ● Parent commitment to have your child attend all live sessions ● Student must be passing courses and turning in all work ● Failure to adhere to these guidelines would result in a removal from the program and return to in-person learning
