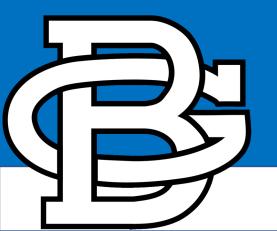
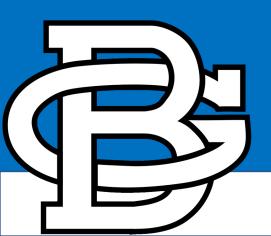

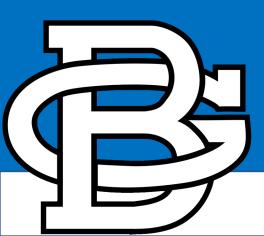
Continue to Learn

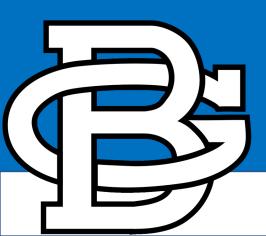
