1. CALL TO ORDER – Dr. Natalie Wargo, President, 5:39 pm

2. CONFIRMATION OF BOARD OF FINANCE MEMBERS & ELECTION OF OFFICERS

A. President

Mary Harlow made a motion to nominate Natalie Wargo as President of the Board of Finance, seconded by Eric McGinty. There was no discussion and the motion carried 5-0.

B. Secretary

Jeannette Skibbie made a motion to nominate Mary Harlow as Secretary of the Board of Finance, seconded by Eric McGinty. There was no discussion and the motion carried 5-0.

3. PRESENTATION OF INVESTMENT REPORT – Mrs. Kathleen Smith

Mrs. Smith presented our annual fiscal indicators and answered questions from the board:

Our ADM (average daily membership) is fairly constant. We did have a drop during COVID, which we have not yet recovered from, however our graduating classes (126-132 students) have been larger than our kindergarten classes (average 100-107 students). We are expecting a small drop in the fall and the following year, as well.

Our fund balances do fluctuate some. In our Education and Operations funds, we always try to maintain a 10% cash balance.

Annual deficit and surplus – our revenues did exceed our expenditures for the year.

If we received no revenue, our funds would run out in about 2.9 months, or 86.5 days. Our goal is to always have a 3-month supply of funds on hand.

We receive the largest chunk of our funding from local tax and state revenue.

Mrs. Smith advised the board on how to access this information should they be interested in exploring in more detail.

4. ADJOURNMENT

Mary Harlow made a motion for adjournment at 5:47 pm, seconded by Eric McGinty. The motion carried 5-0.
